

A few tips that may help you on the "Big Day". Remember a well loaded van can hold a lot more items than one loaded at random:

- Take time out and plan, room by room, exactly how you are going to load your vehicle.
- Load the larger items first.
- Protect all items well, to avoid breakages.
- Wrap small breakable items in bubble wrap or newspaper and pack safely in cardboard boxes (or an empty drawer is ideal).
- Try to pack the vehicle as tight as possible.
- Fill all available space to stop items shifting during transit (a mattress or cushions are ideal padding between items to avoid damage).
- Make large items smaller if you can i.e. if legs can be removed from a table do so, if bunk beds come apart etc.
